BIOGRAPHY

Birdbones is a four-piece band based in Luxembourg. Progressive rock is their main influence, which they topup with rock-solid pulsating grooves, pervasive guitar riffs and haunting vocals.

Founded in 2010, Birdbones had an extensive presence throughout Luxembourg in 2011 and the following years. They played on numerous regional festivals and venues like Food For Your Senses, E-Lake, Rock-um-Knuedler, Fête de la Musique, Rockhal and Atelier. Furthermore, they had the honor to open for acts like Macy Gray, Bush and Stornoway.

In 2011, they released their first single "Every Single One Of Us", including an inspirational videoclip produced by Feierblumm Productions. The single was regularly played on the radio and landed the band a steady place in the local music scene.

After line-up changes in 2012 and the introduction of the Amsterdam-based singer Romy, they started working on their first album "Phoenix". The title reflects the bands' story and creative process, which is marked by the dynamics of creation, rejection and recreation.

Released in 2013, this album marks an important landmark the band draws on, while at the same time following their urge to explore new ideas and redefine themselves.

In 2014, Birdbones won the EUmusicmatch contest in Sardinia, Italy. They stood out against 300 bands and won over both the jury and the public. Using this vital momentum in their career, they continue to look ahead and spread their wings to reach new territories.
